
# Souderton Borough Collection Zones

# Trash, Bulk, Single-Stream Recycling & Yard Waste Collection Information

# Important information associated with Trash, Bulk, Single-Stream Recycling & Yard Waste Collection

- ★ TRASH: one (1) time per week collected THURSDAY OR FRIDAY
- ★ BULK ITEM: one (1) time per week collected THURSDAY OR FRIDAY
- ★ RECYCLING: one (1) time per week collected THURSDAY OR FRIDAY

### **SOLID WASTE COLLECTION**



Sons, all solid waste should be placed curb side no later than 6 A.M. the day of your scheduled pickup. Refuse/solid waste is to be placed in new 96 gallon red toters with lids provided to all residents. Residents may use additional trash cans if needed.

### **OPTIONAL SOLID WASTE PRE BAG PROGRAM**

Souderton Borough offers an optional trash bag program for residents who do not expect to generate average amount of household trash. Under this program residents must purchase specially colored and marked trash bags from the Borough office at a cost of \$4.00 per bag. Note: no more than four (4) bags can be placed out for collection at one time and this option will not allow for bulk item collection.

## SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING COLLECTION

Serviced by J.P. Mascaro & Sons, single-stream



recyclables are to be placed loose in the new 64 gallon red toter with a blue lid provided to all residents. Recyclables can be mixed together. NO SORTING **NEEDED**. Recycle newspapers, inserts & junk mail, magazines, catalogs and envelopes, paper back books and phone books,

Serviced by J.P. Mascaro & cardboard, clean pizza boxes, office & school papers (colored paper), box board (cereal, cake & cracker boxes); paper egg cartons, paper bags, aluminum cans & clean foil; tin & empty steel aerosol cans, empty glass jars & bottles, and all plastic containers labeled #1-#7.

## DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING IN THE **RECYCLING TOTER:**

- NO garbage
- NO plastic bags
- NO food waste
- NO styrofoam

NO batteries

- NO motor oil
- NO plastic toys
- NO electronics
- NO CDs or DVDs
- NO egg cartons
- NO light bulbs
- NO hangers
- NO yard waste

#### **BULK ITEM COLLECTION**

Serviced by J.P. Mascaro & Sons. One bulk item (i.e. mattress, furniture, etc.) per household is permitted per week. No tires, TVs or computers. Call J.P. Mascaro & Sons at 1-800-432-1616 for "white" item pickup (i.e. washing machine). For items containing Freon (i.e. refrigerators, air conditioners window units) visit Montgomery Countys website www.montgomerycountyrecycles.org or call 610-278-3618 for a list of companies that will remove Freon and dispose of the appliance for a fee. Residents must be on site at time of scheduled pick-up.

#### **LEAF COLLECTION:**

Serviced by Borough Public Works Department. Actual dates to be announced. Bring leaves to the curb. Please remember that leaves will be collected with vacuum equipment, which is designed to pick up only leaf waste. Piles of leaves that contain excessive quantities of sticks, stones, hedge clippings, plant materials, and other trash will not be removed.

#### **BRUSH & CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION**

The Borough Public Works Department will pick up free of charge. Brush collection will occur on the first week of every month. Sticks and branches can range from 1 inch to 6 inches in diameter. Christmas trees: clear all ornaments, garlands, lights, stands, and any nails or fasteners and place the tree in your front vard next to the sidewalk.

#### HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

If a holiday is within your scheduled collection week then your collection will take place one day late. Holidays: New Year's Day (January 1), Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (December 25).
