# ALLEN TOWNSHIP SERVICE COLLECTION INFORMATION

- ★ **TRASH COLLECTION:** one (1) time per week collected **THURSDAY**
- ★ **BULK ITEM COLLECTION:** one (1) item per week per residence to be collected with your weekly garbage collection on **THURSDAY**
- ★ **RECYCLING COLLECTION:** every other week collected **THURSDAY**  
Collection divided into **two (2) collection zones**

**NORTH** = North of Route 329 / on Route 329

**SOUTH** = South of Route 329

## Curbside Trash and Recycling Collection

As a service to its residents and property owners, Allen Township contracts with a garbage hauler to provide weekly curbside garbage collection and bi-weekly recycling collection. The current hauler (effective June 3rd 2022) is J.P. Mascaro & Sons. Residents can place **UNLIMITED** garbage for collection beginning with the collection on **Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 (Note: This is due to the holiday (Memorial Day)).** Please place your trash at the curb by 6 PM each Wednesday for collection on Thursday. See calendar for any holiday exceptions.

## Single-Stream Recycling Collection

Residents will continue to utilize the red recycling containers, which are available at the Township building. Recycling collection will occur every other week depending on your location. Please refer to attached collection zone map. North collection zone will be addresses North of Route 329 and includes addresses ON Route 329. South collection zone will be addresses south of Route 329. **While recycling amounts remain UNLIMITED, the most important goal is to avoid contamination of valuable, clean recyclable materials in your recycling bins by not mixing these materials with unrecyclable junk - which include plastic bags, plastic wrap, straws and bottle caps.**

### UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses, glass oven ware, pyrex, VisionWare, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, plastics without #1-#7 labeling, plastic bags, styrofoam packaging, bubble wrap, tissue or paper towels, books and toys. Food contaminated cardboard (i.e. pizza boxes) and paper towels.

## The Allen Township Electronic Recycling Event

(Township residents only) has been scheduled for September 10, 2022 from 9 AM to 12 PM (noon) at the Allen Township Fire Company Building.

If you are unsure if an item is categorized as White Metal Goods, Bulk or Electronics give the Township Office or J.P. Mascaro a call to discuss before you place out for disposal.

## 2022 WEEKLY Bulk Curbside Collection

Each residence may put one (1) bulk item per week to be collected along with their weekly garbage collection. Bulk items include those items too large to fit in to normal garbage cans and are further defined as items having the approximate size and weight of a standard size sofa that can be carried by two (2) men. Examples include furniture, mattresses, rolled up and tied rugs no larger than 3' x 6'. Due to a growing problem with bed bugs, all mattresses and box springs **MUST** be wrapped with plastic before placement at the curb for collection. Unacceptable materials that will NOT be collected include construction materials, hazardous waste, electronics, tires, yard waste or grass clippings.

## White Item or Metal Goods Collection

Appliances such as air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers (doors and Freon removed), washers, dryers, hot water heaters, dehumidifiers, bicycles, and lawn mowers (oil and gas removed), BBQ grills (gas and/or charcoal removed), and various other household metal items will be accepted twice (Spring and Fall) per on the dates listed. Fall collection will be \_\_\_\_\_. Electronics are not included in the White/ Metal Goods curbside collection dates.

## 2022 Allen Township Yard Waste Drop Off

Yard waste is no longer allowed in landfills in the State of Pennsylvania. Unlimited amounts of yard waste (leaves, branches, twigs, flowers, roots, bushes, garden clippings) may be brought to the Allen Township Municipal Drop Off during the hours listed below. Proof of residency will be required for yard waste.

## Allen Township Yard Waste Drop Off Hours:

Monday through Friday (with the exception of Township holidays) 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Saturday Hours: April 16th to October 29, 2022, 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. When dropping off your yard waste materials the following rules apply: Yard waste is accepted in loose form or in compostable paper bags only. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** Tie with cotton or hemp twine in bundles no larger than 3' x 3' x 3', and weighing no more than 40 lbs.

**ITEMS WHICH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT ALLEN TOWNSHIP YARD WASTE DROP OFF SITE INCLUDE:** Grass clippings, tree stumps, loose soils, sod, any wood or tree limbs over four (4) inches in diameter human or animal excrement; noxious weeds or soils contaminated with hazardous substances.

## Electronics Recycling (No E-Waste Collection)



No person may dispose of a electronic waste, or any of its components, with their municipal solid waste collection. These items are required to either be to be transferred to certified electronics recycling facilities (if the item is intact). If the item has been physically broken and the original components are not intact the item must be treated as hazardous waste.
