SUBJECT: MASCARO WINS CONTRACT VALUED AT \$23 MILLION TO

SERVE WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY

On September 9, J.P. Mascaro & Sons secured a 5-year, \$23 million contract to provide comprehensive waste, recycling, leaf collection, and disposal services for all the homes in Whitehall Township, Lehigh County. Whitehall is a major municipality within Lehigh County with a population approximately of 27,000 residents.
